For competitors to earn his/her full payout in the final 2019 championship standings, competitors will be required to attend at least 80% of the tour's point events and be a member in good standing with the Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series. The season-ending championship point standings will be based on 80% of completed events during 2019. For example, if 20 events are successfully completed, competitors 16 best point totals will count towards the season-ending championship standings. The championship point fund is detailed below:
