Weisser Takes Summit Racing Equipment AMS Victory at Fairbury Speedway

The Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series would visit the Fairbury Speedway in Fairbury, IL Saturday night. Allen Weisser from Peoria, IL would be victorious in his #25 Lethal Chassis entry and collect the \$2,000 pay day!

A strong field of AMS entries would battle 30-laps around the fast quarter-mile of Fairbury Speedway as Trent Young and Mike McKinney would lead the field into turn-one followed by Allen Weisser and Michael Long. McKinney would narrowly grab the lead off turn-four to complete the opening circuit. The trio of McKinney, Weisser, and Young would battle three-wide on lap-two with Weisser assuming the top spot. Weisser would immediately begin to stretch his early lead as a host of contenders would battle for the second position. The event's first caution would fly on lap-nine as Daniel Rork would suffer a flat right-front tire. On the restart, Weisser would continue to lead the field while navigating his Lethal Chassis around the bottom groove of the speedway. As the event neared the halfway point, Mike Harrison would begin to make his presence known moving into the third position utilizing the famous FALS cushion. The event would be slowed once again on lap-fourteen as Danny Schwartz would spin and come to a halt in turn-four. On the lap-fourteen restart, a multi-car accident that included Kenny Wallace, Jeff Leka, Devin Wright, and others would occur in turn-four prompting the red-flag. On the restart, Weisser would continue his dominance at the front of the field as Mike Harrison would move into the second position. Weisser would begin to encounter lap-traffic in the final ten laps of the event that would allow Harrison to close the gap. Harrison would continue to challenge Weisser throughout the remainder of the event, but could never pull along-side Weisser. Weisser would claim his first series victory of the 2019 season with Harrison a very close second. QuickCar Racing Products Fast Time Award Winner Jeffrey Ledford would claim the third position, while Trent Young would place fourth and Michael Long would round out the top five.



The remainder of the top ten at the completion of the Summit Racing Equipment A-Main at Fairbury Speedway would be Mike McKinney, Ray Bollinger, Gabriel Kirtley, Brian Shaw, and Jay Leford.

The next event for the Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series will be May 26th at Fayette County Speedway. The event will pay \$3,000.00 to the winner. Sunday's event will also see the make-up A-Main from April 13th.
