### Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series at Moler June 23, Florence June 24

Both series events will be 30 laps and pay \$1,500 to win and \$200 to start.

Other divisions joining the Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series in action at Moler Raceway Park on Friday June 23 will be the track's Late Model, Cohen Recycling Crazy Compacts, and Diamond Cut Lawn Care Sport Mod divisions. Entry fee for the Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series is \$50. All drivers that start a B-Main, but do not transfer to the A-Main, will receive \$50 tow money.

The following evening on Saturday June 24, the Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series will visit Florence Speedway in Union, KY. The tour will be in competition in a full program of practice, A-B group time trials, qualifying heats, B Mains, and a 30 lap, \$1,500 to win/\$200 to start A-Main event. Activities for the Saturday June 24 event at Florence Speedway will see the pit area open at 4:00 p.m. and general admission area open at 5:00 p.m. The drivers meeting will be at 5:15 p.m., with practice laps set to begin at 5:30 p.m., followed by time trials and racing at 7:00 p.m. All times EDT. Ticket prices for Florence Speedway on Saturday June 24 in the general admission area will be \$25 for adults and children ages 6 to 11 will be \$5. A pit pass will be \$40.
