Hope for Harlie Benefit Event Up Next for the Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series July 19th & 20th

The Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series will return to action at Cedar Ridge Speedway on Friday, July 19th and Saturday, July 20th for the annual "Hope for Harlie" benefit event.

Both events will see the tour in competition with a full program of practice, time trials presented by QuickCar Racing Products, qualifying heat races, B-Mains, and A-Main events. Friday, July 19th will pay \$1,500 to win/\$150 to start and Saturday, July 20th will pay \$6,000 to win/\$1,000 to start. Entry fee for the Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series is \$50 for each event. All drivers that start a B-Main, but do not transfer to the A-Main will receive \$50 tow money.

Cedar Ridge Speedway will host an "open practice" session on Thursday, July 18th. All gates will open at 3:00 P.M. with "open practice" scheduled for 5:00 P.M – 9:00 P.M. All times are CST.

Activities at Cedar Ridge Speedway on Friday, July 19th will see both the general admission and pit area open at 2:00 P.M. Activities on Saturday, July 20th will see both the general admission and pit area open at 12:00 P.M. On both Friday and Saturday, the driver's meeting will be at 6:00 P.M. followed by time trials at 6:45 P.M. with green flag racing starting shortly after the conclusion of time trials. Ticket prices at Cedar Ridge Speedway for single-day general admission will be \$15 for adults (children 8 and under are free) and \$40 for adult pit admission (children 6-10 are \$15, 5 and under are free). Two-day adult general admission ticket is \$25 and adult pit admission is \$75.

Under the guideline of the 2019 DIRTcar UMP Modified rules, only tires approved for DIRTcar competition are the **Hoosier: M-30S and M-60 compounds** in the DIRTcar plated tire 26.5/8.0/15 or 27.5/8.0/15. The maximum width of the tire will be 9 inches. **The M-60 may be used as a right rear option tire. NO GROOVING ALLOWED. Siping permitted on M-30 and M-60.**
