



Nicely Thursday Night Winner at Farmer City

(Sept 2, 2021) – The Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series kicked off the Labor Day weekend at Farmer City Raceway. Thursday night was the start of four nights of racing with \$19,000 up for grabs in winners share.

Twenty-five cars signed in and looked to lay down the quickest lap in Allstar Performance qualifying. Mike Harrison was quickest at 13.954 seconds. Michael Ledford of Pontiac, IL was second quick at 13.993 and Dustin King was third quick at 14.034 seconds. This determined the lineups for three eight lap heat races.

In Hypercoils Heat Race #1 Tyler Nicely picked up the heat race win over Mike Harrison. Kenny Wallace finished third ahead of Victor Lee who came home fourth. Zac Oedewaldt finished out the top 5 and all transferred into the main event.

It was Michael Ledford who came home with the win in Willy's Carb & Dyno Heat Race #2. Plainfield, IL driver Mike McKinney was runner up. Will Krup passed the stripe in third. Allen Weisser and Ryan Thomas nabbed the final two transfer spots.

Owensboro, KY driver Cole Falloway won Fast Shafts Heat Race #3. Dustin King from Charleston, IL got the runner up spot. Farmer City legend Jeff Leka was third. Jacob Rexing and Ray Bollinger picked up the final two transfer spots into the nights feature event.

In the \$1,500 to win main event Tyler Nicely used the outside front row starting spot to come home with the win. Farmer City track Champion Michael Ledford gave it his best effort to try and pick up the win but, in the end, it was Tyler Nicely who got the victory. Mike Harrison rounded out the top three. Mike McKinney and Cole Falloway finished fourth and fifth.

The hard charger of the night was Series points leader Brian Shaw who came from the twentieth starting spot to finish fourteenth.
