Trent Young Summit Racing Equipment AMS Tri-State Speedway Harvest Cup Winner

Chandler, IN (October 7, 2016)- The Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series would conclude its a two-race weekend on Saturday with its first-ever appearance at Tri-State Speedway in Haubstadt, IN for the track's Harvest Cup event and current series points leader Trent Young would find victory lane with the series for the eighth time this season with the tour and pick up the \$1,500 payday. Young's victory would come aboard the Dave Mitchell owned Snap-On Tools/Mitchell Tools and Motorsports/Ted Brown's Quality Paint and Body/R&S Equipment/Emma's Place/Young's Well Service/Kissinger Red Angus sponsored #10Y Bandit Race Car, SPEC Race Engines powered entry.

Young would start fourth in the 30 lap, \$1,500 to win contest and would finally grab the race lead and drive to his second victory of the weekend. Tyler Nicely would drive home with runner-up honors, Josh Harris would finish in the third position. Top qualifier Lucas Lee would finish in the fourth position, while Dustin Beck would charge from the thirteenth starting position to finish in the fifth position.

The remainder of the top ten at the completion of the Tri-State Speedway Harvest Cup A-Main event would be Stan Beadles, Brian Shaw, Everett Bradham, Clayton Lane, and Mark Lamont.

In preliminary action, Lucas Lee was the Quick Car Racing Products top qualifier among 33 entries at 15.627 seconds. Summit Racing Equipment heat one went to Clayton Lane, while Everett Bradham scored the win in Fast Shafts heat two. Hypercoils heat three went to Tyler Nicely and Frankland Racing Equipment heat four would be won by Trent Young. The Out-Pace Race Products B-Mains were won by Zach Fair and Steven Schnapf. Series provisional starting spots went to Lance Foreman and David Baldwin.

The Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series will complete its 2016 race season on Saturday October 22 with the tour's 7th Annual Season Championship event at Florence Speedway in Union, KY. The event will pay \$5,000 to win and \$250 to start.
