Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series Closes 2015 Season at Florence Speedway October 23, 24

Glasgow, KY-October 9, 2015- The Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series will close out the 2015 racing tour with a Friday and Saturday doubleheader of racing action at Florence Speedway in Union, KY on Friday October 23 and Saturday October 24.
